



## Group Consultations Facilitator Training

### Who is this for?

This event is intended for **general practice staff** whom wish to become group consultation facilitators; the role would suit anyone in primary care whom enjoys working directly with patients, even if they don't have a clinical background.

### What is this?

This interactive half-day training has been developed in partnership with NHSE/I South West, following their ongoing workshops on implementation of group consultations in general practice.

**Group consultations** are shared medical appointments, delivered by a clinician and a facilitator to a group of patients whom have similar health issues. The facilitator's role is to coordinate the group consultation, to support patients in contributing to and getting the most from their time with the clinician and their peers.

This session will be run by an experienced facilitation skills coach and not only give you the confidence to engage with patient groups, but also the practical skills to run the group consultation process effectively.
